- Starting from June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, curfew electronic permits will not be effective unless the holder is registered on the vaccination platform (vaccine.jo).
- Those who have passed 21 days since the first vaccination dose will be able to move during curfew hours.
- Shortening partial curfews hours (12:00 am for facilities, 1:00 am for individuals), and considering the vaccination certificate a permit to move during curfew hours.
- Starting from July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, curfew electronic permits will be canceled unless the holder has received the first vaccination dose, except for those who do not require vaccination (infected/health reasons).
- Canceling partial and total lockdown in all governorates starting from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
