		VisitJordan platform for documentation purposes and receiving related QR Codes, in addition to approval purposes for land arrivals who do not obtain an approved vaccination certificate.
Allowing hookah service in a facility's outdoor area.	June 15 th 2021	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The facility wishing to reopen must submit a request to the Ministry and sign a commitment to abide by the approved health protocols. 2. All employees must be vaccinated; 21 days should have passed since the first vaccination dose. 3. The facility is allowed to serve customers who have passed 21 days since the first vaccination dose, except for those under 18 years of age or who do not require vaccination. 4. Operating by a maximum of 50% capacity. All tables must be 2 meters apart with a maximum capacity of 6 people per table. 5. Abiding by all approved health and safety protocols and preventative measures. 6. Appointing a health monitoring officer from the facility's staff to ensure the entity is abiding by the health and safety measures.

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- Starting from June 15th, 2021, curfew electronic permits will not be effective unless the holder is registered on the vaccination platform (vaccine.jo).
- Those who have passed 21 days since the first vaccination dose will be able to move during curfew hours.
- Shortening partial curfews hours (12:00 am for facilities, 1:00 am for individuals), and considering the vaccination certificate a permit to move during curfew hours.
- Starting from July 15th, 2021, curfew electronic permits will be canceled unless the holder has received the first vaccination dose, except for those who do not require vaccination (infected/health reasons).
- Canceling partial and total lockdown in all governorates starting from September 1st, 2021.
